Тип урока: комбинированный урок

Цель урока: активизировать знания учащихся по теме "Театр", развивать навыки и умения в работе над косвенной речью.

Задачи урока:

Образовательные: систематизировать знания учащихся по теме "Teatp"; научить работать с различными заданиями; активизировать работу каждого учащегося.
